DELTA AND WESTJET ANNOUNCE JOINT VENTURE PLANS

Delta and WestJet have set the wheels in motion to create a new transborder joint venture to offer customers an extensive network between the U.S. and Canada.

Subject to regulatory approvals, the joint venture will provide service to more than 30 cities covering over 95% of U.S.-Canada demand, benefiting customers connecting via New York-JFK from Tel Aviv.

DELTA BREAKS JULY PASSENGER RECORDS

In July 2018, Delta flew more people in a single month than it ever has in its history. For the month, Delta flew nearly 18.3 million customers - more than half a million more than the previous record of 17.7 million set in June this year.

Passenger boarding peaked at nearly 662,000 on July 26 — the highest single-day record for the airline.

Meanwhile, and despite the high customer volumes, Delta saw a 99.31 percent completion factor for July across its mainline and Delta Connection system.



DELTA TO FLY TWICE DAILY FROM TEL AVIV

Delta will double its flights from Tel Aviv to New York's John F. Kennedy International airport for summer 2019, offering two daily services from June 17, 2019.

The new flight has been scheduled as a daytime departure from Tel Aviv, completing the existing night-time departure to offer customers more choice. Altogether, Delta is adding 4,000 more seats each week between the two cities.

Both flights will be operated using Airbus A330-300 aircraft with 293 seats.

Delta's second daily nonstop flight between Tel Aviv and New York-JFK is scheduled as follows:
